Personal data is processed for the purpose of:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) For marketing purposes - pursuant to article 6 paragraph 1(a) GDPR,</li> <li>b) conclusion and performance of the contract - pursuant to article 6 paragraph (1) (b) GDPR,</li> <li>c) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject - pursuant to article 6 paragraph 1 (c) GDPR.</li> </ul>
The Controller processes your personal data in connection with the legitimate interest pursued by the Controller, which consists in:	transferring marketing information - pursuant to art. 6 paragraph 1 f) of the GDPR.
The period for which personal data will be stored is:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) in the case of ordering a service, for tax purposes, personal data will be processed for 5 years from the end of the tax year in which the last invoice was issued,</li> <li>b) for marketing purposes, until the consent is withdrawn or the objection is raised.</li> </ul>
Providing your personal data is:	voluntary, but necessary to provide the service. If an invoice is issued, the data is processed on the basis of the requirements of tax law.
Failure to provide data will have the following consequences:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) a) the service cannot be provided,</li> <li>b) b) it is not possible to issue an invoice.</li> </ul>
Consent to the processing of personal data:	It is collected for marketing purposes or handling inquiries sent via electronic channels.
The recipient of basic contact details such as name, first and last name, position, telephone number or e-mail address may be:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Entities cooperating in the provision of the service or providing support services for the controller,</li> <li>b) entities process data on the basis of concluded entrustment agreements (e.g. accounting office, entity providing support in the field of IT services),</li> <li>c) public entities authorized under the provisions of law.</li> </ul>
Recipients of data whose registered offices are located outside the EEA may be:	entities with whom agreements regarding tourism cooperation have been concluded or will be.
In addition, we would like to inform you about the right to request the Controller to access your personal data, the right to rectify, delete or limit processing, and the right to object to the processing, as well as the right to transfer data and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.	
The Controller will not make decisions in an automated manner, and you will not be profiled.
